Answering the challenges of our culture: We have reached a watershed moment in America—sex and gender have become a continental divide and polarizing force. It is only a matter of time before we will be singled out and publicly ostracized. **The need is urgent for believers to equip one another to respond to the kinds of objections to Scripture which arise from advocates of homosexuality and gender fluidity.** The words of the apostle Peter anticipate opposition to our faith, but also the opportunity to bear witness of the truth in Christ: “But even if you should suffer for the sake of righteousness, *you are* blessed and do not fear their intimidation, and do not be troubled, but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, **always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence; and keep a good conscience so that in the thing in which you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ will be put to shame**” (1 Pet 3:14-16).
