The Importance of Discipling in Perseverance

Dear Friends, the Lord continues to provide GFL with some exciting new ministry opportunities. GFL's discipleship ministry is growing in San Diego. I recently met a neighbor while taking my morning prayer walk. I told him I was a pastor and that I disciple several men each week. He wanted to meet for discipleship. As I got to know him, I found out he used to attend a seeker-friendly church, and he assumed he was a Christian. I met with him several times and shared the gospel with him. He attended our biweekly Bible study and wept after hearing the clear message of Christ. He purchased a Bible, and surprised us by meeting us at church. He continues to meet privately for discipleship and appears to have become a true believer. I am so grateful for these opportunities to help Christian men reach spiritual maturity by *teaching them to obey* all that Christ has commanded. GFL has been asked by a home school group to create Christian Worldview curriculum for 9th-12th graders. The crucial relevance of Christian Worldview training at this time in our nation cannot be overstated. The 26 lesson course includes a teacher's guide, illustrations, discussion points and homework.






Training our disciples in perseverance is an essential aspect of "teaching them to obey all that Christ has commanded" (Mt 28:19-20). Perseverance is a vital dimension of Christian

character: "Now for this very reason also, applying all diligence, in your faith supply moral excellence, and in *your* moral excellence, knowledge, and in *your* knowledge, selfcontrol, and in *your* self-control, **perseverance**, and in *your* perseverance, godliness"(2 Pet 1:5-6). Perseverance enables the believer to **finish well**: "For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, you may receive what was promised" (Heb 10:36).

The command to endure and persevere presupposes that **our progress to glory will be opposed by the world, the flesh, and the devil**. Paul, in discipling the Thessalonian believers, prepared them for inevitable affliction: "We sent Timothy, our brother and God's fellow worker in the gospel of Christ, to strengthen and encourage you as to your faith, so that no one would be **disturbed by these afflictions**; for you yourselves know that we have been **destined for this**" (1 Thess 3:2-3).

As a faithful discipler, Paul set an example of perseverance for Timothy, charging him to imitate his example (1 Tim 6:11; 2 Tim 3:10). God's grace includes the ability to persevere, for all true believers have the confidence that they will persevere to the end because our Lord perseveres in keeping them (Phil 1:6). The last 9 books of the New Testament contain the largest number of warnings about apostasy, as well as the majority of the exhortations to **persevere**. We must not neglect this crucial doctrine, but continue to exhort our disciples to excel in earnestness, patience, and steadfastness. For the testing of the genuineness of our faith is par for the course, it is the 'normal Christian life' (1 Pet 1:6-9).
