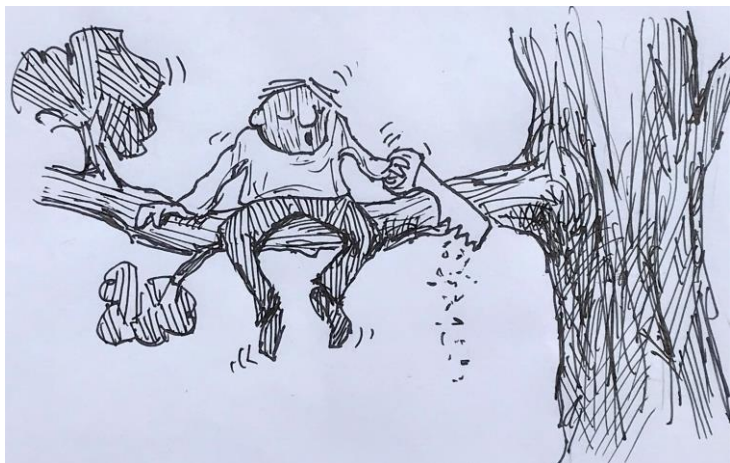




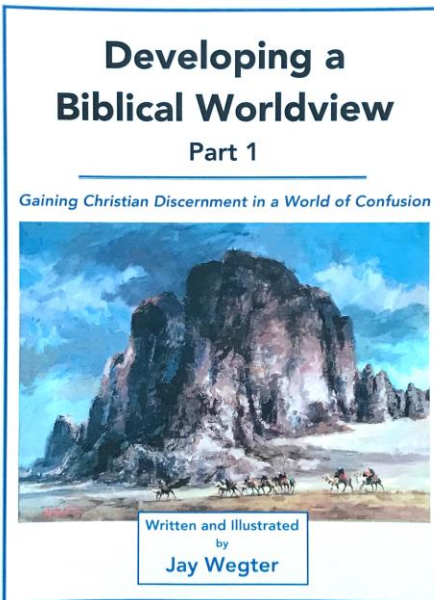
Homeschool Academy looks to GFL for Worldview Curriculum

It is a great privilege for us at GFL to write **Biblical Worldview curriculum for high school students**. ‘Christian’ college students who leave the faith tend to be those who were never taught a unified worldview with Biblical creation as its foundation. This makes them astonishingly vulnerable to erroneous worldviews. Public high school and college campuses are indoctrinating our youth in the satanic philosophies of humanism and naturalism at an alarming rate. Rampant moral decay is the result—accompanied by a gross loss of confidence in the reliability of the Scriptures.

In a massive ‘redefinition campaign’ the *political left* is saturating the academy and popular culture with buzz-words such as, *inclusion, equality, social justice, systemic racism, transgenderism, identity politics, the new tolerance, etc.*). The philosophies behind these terms constitute an all-out war against the knowledge of Almighty God. Just beneath the surface of this culture war, a spiritual war is raging—it is a battle to the death for the eternal souls of men, women, and children—and our young people are particularly at risk.



In our Biblical worldview book, numerous illustrations help fix concepts in the minds of students.



Biblical worldview is about how life works in God’s world. It sets forth God’s loving ‘blueprint’ for us, and it is governed by His character and truth.

We are to follow this design in order to discern what is good and wise and right and holy (Prov 1:7).

The worldview of secular humanism denies God, Christ, and the Bible. Thus, people are led to make decisions based upon their felt needs and desires. Each individual becomes ‘a law unto himself’. God says in Judges 21:25, “In those days there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes.” There could hardly be a more accurate assessment of our country today than the description found in this passage.

We are standing at a crossroads in human history. Now is the time for believers to become proactive in becoming equipped in Biblical worldview. Believing students who are trained in Biblical worldview develop the resolve and discernment to live life without compromise. They learn to live in light of God’s total truth, for His honor and glory. Training in Biblical worldview enables Christians to stand firm in the face of our culture’s non-biblical ideas, and to tear down the atheistic ideals of false worldviews. **Consider how crucial training in Biblical worldview actually is:** among those young people who have not received equipping in Christian worldview, over 80% of students from ‘Christian’ homes deny the faith before graduation from college.

Believers committed to Biblical Worldview learn to bring every area of life under the lordship of Christ. Therefore, there are no compartments 'exempt' from the lordship of Christ. To hold to a unified Biblical view that incorporates every part of God's blueprint is never an accident; it is always the result of systematic training. In order to be fully grasped, Biblical worldview must be diligently taught (1 Tim 4:6). God has called us not only to personal faith, but also to a Biblical worldview which has the power to bring unified truth to all of life, and to transform the world today.



The great gospel mystery that the Son of God became incarnate in order to give His life as a sacrifice for sin is at the heart of our worldview (Jn 1:14, 29).

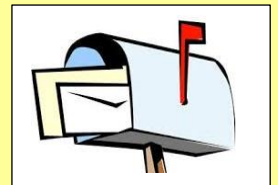
