Dear Praying Friends, we are praising the Lord and are very encouraged! Thank you so much for your prayers on our behalf.

Michele's *tumor marker blood work* has indicated a drop again:

From 21.2 down to 15.2 (Normal 0-37) and, from 11.6 down to 6.2 (Normal range 0-5).

Reports of recent scans of chest, abdomen, and pelvis now show **CANCER IS NO LONGER PRESENT in breast or pelvic area as in previous scans!**

Remaining cancer is in the sternum, but the tumors on the spine are considered treated and inactive. Also, a recent test showed minimal fluid in left lung (originally a quart).

She has gained 15 lbs of muscle weight since Dec 2020. She needs 10 more lbs in order to reach normal weight. Her workouts on weight machines four times a week, and daily walks, continue to improve her strength and mobility!

A disciple-making challenge to

believing men: 1) Discipleship is not only teaching, it is modeling a life worthy of being imitated by a disciple (Lu 6:40). Because of that reality, it is easy to see why many men opt out of disciple-making. Why? They may lack a Christian life worthy of imitation.

- 2) Also, countless believing men falsely assume that ministry is best conducted by trained professionals. Consequently they do not regard their spiritual influence in home and church to be absolutely crucial to the health of the Body.
- 3) And, finally, only if men are committed to grow as *theologizers*, will their calling to be spiritual influencers flourish.

The solution to these common areas of weakness will not be solved by one more seminar. The answer is found in faithfulness to the Great Commission. For, our Lord's last command is His mandate for the church: *believers are to teach one another to observe/obey what Christ has commanded.* Discipleship is about learning obedience in a context of life-on-life soul care. This is only way that the men of the church can be empowered, and released to ministry (this is an excerpt from the November-December 2021 GFL Article of the Month).
